KIRIT SOMAIYA FILES HIS NOMINATION PAPERS.

BJP –Shiv Sena candidate from North East Mumbai, Dr. Kirit Somaiya filed his nomination papers for the forthcoming Loksabha election at the Tehsildar Office in Mulund.

He was accompanied by Shiv Sena leader and ex- Minister Adv. Liladhar Dake, BJP Mumbai President, Mr. Gopal Shetty(MLA), Sardar Tara Singh(MLA from Mulund) and Shri Dattaram Gujar, Shiv Sena Vibhag Pramukh.

After filing his nomination Shri Somaiya inaugurated his “Jana Suraksha Rath” and BJP’s new Election Office in Mulund (W) in the presence of thousands of party workers.

Speaking on the occasion, Shri Somaiya lambasted the govt. for the rising prices of essential commodities. As an example, he quoted Sugar – whose price had gone up from Rs. 18.50/- per kg in October 2008 to Rs. 27/- per kg in March 2009.

He criticized that the candidate of the Sugar lobby and his bosses will have to answer the public as to why sugar had turned sour?

Speaking on the occasion, Mr Prakash Mehta ridiculed the sitting Congress MP for fudging away from a fight and stated that this action conclusively proved that the wind was blowing in favour of the BJP-Shiv Sena alliance.

Sardar Tara Singh said that Kirit Somaiya’s victory was a foregone conclusion and urged the workers to work to increase the margin.
