MAHARASHTRA VIDHAN SABHA ELECTIONS

BOGUS BANGLADESHI VOTERS ENROLMENT STARTED AGAIN

It is a repetition of Lok Sabha voters' enrolment scenario now at the time of preparation of voters' enrolment for October 2009 Maharashtra Vidhan Sabha elections, stated BJP leader, Dr. Kirit Somaiya.

The recently completed voters' enrolment upto July 2009 figures are shocking. Once again, Shivaji Nagar - Mankhurd, i.e. mini Bangladesh of Mumbai, received 21,373 bogus Bangladeshi voters applications, Chandivali 18,643, Bhosari (Pune Dist.) 42,284. Naya Nagar – this is another mini-Bangladesh of Mira Road – has received 13,305 application forms.

It may be noted that the adjacent Assembly areas to Shivaji Nagar - Mankhurd, Chembur has received normal voters enrolment of 2313 and Ghatkopar East 4606. Similarly, adjacent Vidhan Sabha to Mira Road, i.e. Kopri Panchpakhadi received 2653 and Kalyan Rural 1703 application forms.

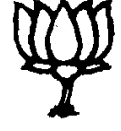
Dr. Somaiya charged that the staff of the Election Office was pressurized to accept thousands of Bangladeshi voters' enrolment applications. Dr. Somaiya is taking up this issue once again with the Election Commission on 7th August 2009 at Delhi.

It may be noted that similar efforts to infiltrate voters list for Lok Sabha elections were made in 2008. 1,63,000 such bogus Bangladeshi voters enrolment forms were scrapped by the Election Commission due to the efforts of Dr. Somaiya.
