

MUMBAI IN LOKSABHA

Ever since Kirit Somaiya was elected to the Lok Sabha in 1999, Mumbai has become a permanent feature in Lok Sabha debates. Kirit Somaiya's Mumbai office has a separate section which interacts with people of Mumbai and addresses issues related to the city.

Using the platform of Parliament he has raised many issues regarding Mumbai with concerned Ministries and sought redressal during the last 3 years.

More than 400 starred and unstarred questions connected to problems of Mumbai have been raised by Kiritbai in Parliament.

Issues ranging from Railways, Skybus, Salt Pan land, Nahur Rly Station, Powai lake rehabilitation, MUTP, MRVC, SEBI, HIV-AIDS, Problems of young deaths in Mumbai & Slums - all these have been highlighted there through Calling Attention Motions, raising issues under Rule 377, Short notice questions, Petitions, Starred & Un-starred questions.

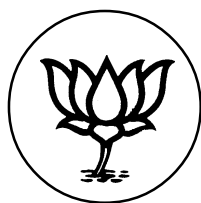
Subsequently these issues were followed up with the concerned Ministries and issues sorted out to their logical solution, for the benefit of Mumbaikars.
